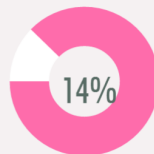


Americans are Divided on Next Steps for the ACA

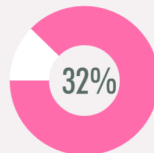
Percentage of Democrats & Republicans that would vote this way



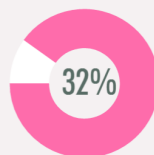
Democrats:

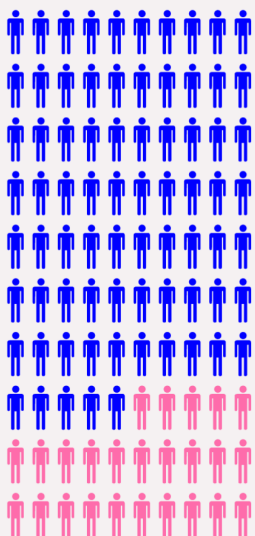
